

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
October 16, 2018**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett and Bradley, Secretary Adkins, also residents Jean Cordrey and Nancy Springer. Commissioners Schneider and Henry were absent.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 1st regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor and chair voted aye, so carried.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 5&6, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor and chair voted aye, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

President Gosnell stated the Farmers Bank of Willards will be submitting new plans for the sidewalks at Pecan Corner which will meet the Town's specifications.

President Gosnell stated Clerk/Treasurer Schneider asked if the Commissioners are agreeable, she would like to pay for the new Town truck in full and then arrange to finance half the cost through Hebron Savings Bank. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to purchase the truck outright and then finance half the cost with Hebron Savings Bank, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor and chair voted aye, so carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

President Gosnell stated the Town of Hebron has purchased new Christmas lights and has offered to give their used ones to Sharptown.

President Gosnell stated November 9th is the last day to file to run for Commissioner in the December 1st election.

President Gosnell stated there was a water leak in the bathroom at the old Town Hall. The carpet will need to be replaced and we are getting quotes for the carpentry work that needs to be done.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. There were none.

President Gosnell asked for public comments. Nancy Springer stated the Historical Commission will sponsor the lighting of the Town Christmas tree on December 2nd at 6pm.

Jean Cordrey asked for clarification on the Pecan Corner update. She next showed the Commissioners the current advertisement that the Town uses in the yearbook at Mardela High School. It is a quarter page ad. She asked the Commissioners to consider enlarging the advertisement to a half page ad, adding a picture along with the Town seal. After discussion, Commissioner Bennett made a motion to contact the school to increase the size of the yearbook

ad, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor and chair voted aye, so carried.

There were no other comments. Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor and chair voted aye, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:45pm.
