

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
October 17, 2016**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:26p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, and Secretary Adkins. Commissioners Thompson and Schneider were absent.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 3rd regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor and Chair voted aye, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor and Chair voted aye, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

The solar project was discussed. The Commissioners reviewed an email from Aaron Goller to MDE with the projected schedule. Secretary Adkins reported that Sandy Rose called and stated the bank approved them to sell the parcel of land. The Commissioners would like to meet with the Rose's on Tuesday October 25 at 7pm to discuss the land purchase.

There was nothing to report on Dollar General.

The USDA requested more information to process the grant application, which Aaron Goller is helping us gather.

The property owner of 305 Water Street stated she has been in contact with some contractors and is awaiting price quotes for the demolition of the house.

The property owner of 102 Ferry Street stated he has met with his contractors and construction of the new home will begin with a couple weeks.

The condition of the old school property was discussed. The Commissioners agreed to send the owner violation letters to get the property cleaned up.

NEW BUSINESS:

The annual Halloween party will be held October 31st at Cope Bennett Ball Park.

The deadline for filing for Town Commissioner in the election is November 14th at 3:30pm. The ad has been placed in the Daily Times. There will also be a flyer placed around town and posted on the Town website.

The topic of filling the vacancy on the Board of Elections will be tabled until the November 7th meeting, when all Commissioners can be in attendance. The three nominees are: Chrys Gosnell, Belinda Thompson, and Nancy Springer.

President Gosnell stated he would like to present the wounded heroes at the Heroes Haven banquet with a key to the town. Also, he would like any Commissioners in attendance to join him for the presentation.

There were no comments so Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor and chair voted aye, so carried.
