

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
October 18, 2021**

Chairperson Bennett called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Henry and Schneider, Secretary Adkins, and Nancy Springer. President Gosnell and Commissioner Bradley were absent.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 4<sup>th</sup> regular meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor and Chair voted aye, so carried.

Commissioner Henry made a motion to pay the bills as stated on page 4 which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor and chair voted aye, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The Commissioners read updates on the WWTP project from Superintendent White and John McGee from DBF.

Secretary Adkins stated the current design of the Town website will not support taking online payments. The Commissioners discussed options for designing a new website and will table the topic until the next meeting.

Chairperson Bennett stated at the last meeting he was mistaken on the area of State Street that needs repair. It was not the sidewalk, but the roadway in the area of where the speed sign is posted. The road dips and water pools there, causing a hazard.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Commissioner Schneider asked about the process for condemning a home. The Commissioners will discuss with Superintendent White.

Chairperson Bennett asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Schneider reported soccer is ongoing. The last game is scheduled for November 6<sup>th</sup>. For Halloween, the Parks and Recreation will request to close certain streets, the costume contest will be handled like last year (submitting photos taken at certain locations around Town), and a hayride will take people around Town between the designated parking areas (Carnival grounds, Old School, and Cope Bennett Park).

Chairperson Bennett and Nancy Springer stated the Historical Commission has ordered more banners to go up on poles. Wicomico County Council person Nicole Acle would like to join the Historical Commission as an honorary member and they are looking into if that is permissible. The Historical Commission is looking into getting plaques for the oldest Historical homes and buildings in Town. The tree lighting at the park on Main Street will be held December 5<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.

Chairperson Bennett asked for public comment. Nancy Springer reminded that the Heroes Haven parade is October 20<sup>th</sup> and to line up on State Street at 5:45pm.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor and the Chair voted aye, so carried.

Chairperson Bennett adjourned the meeting at 7:53p.m.
