

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
October 4, 2021**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Henry, Bradley, and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, Erica Witz, and Nancy Springer.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 20th regular meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5 which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Commissioners read an update on the sewer plant project to MDE from DBF, and Superintendent White stated the old piping has been removed and the new ones have been installed.

Clerk/Treasurer Schneider stated the terminal is take credit/debit card payments is here and ready to accept payments. The ability to accept payments online via the Town website is still being worked on.

Clerk/Treasurer Schneider stated she would like to request permission from the Commissioners to have access to online banking for the Hebron Savings Bank account to more closely monitor when the card payments are deposited to the Town account. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to allow Clerk/Treasurer Schneider to have the ability to access the Hebron Savings Bank accounts online, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell stated, as a reminder, that there will be a meeting at 1:30pm on 10/5 with Wicomico County Public Works to discuss the drainage ditch project.

NEW BUSINESS:

President Gosnell stated he received an email from Wicomico County Parks and Recreation for input on the 2022 Land Preservation, Parks and Recreation Plan (LPPRP). He forwarded it to Mark Carroll and Commissioner Schneider for them to review.

President Gosnell stated Lt. Alessandrini contacted him and said they have a system they can put up in Town to collect traffic data, collect information on how fast people are driving.

President Gosnell stated the Town of Hebron Commission President Rick Dwyer passed away. The Commissioners expressed their condolences.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Bennett stated he received a complaint that the sidewalk in the area of 721 State Street is very low and rain water pools in that area.

Commissioner Bennett stated the Historical Commission would like to have the water reconnected at the Town Park on Main Street. Superintendent White will get a price to do that.

Commissioner Schneider stated the Artisan Market went well. The Parks and Recreation is working on the plans Halloween. Soccer is ongoing.

Superintendent White requested to purchase a computer monitor for a computer at the water plant. President Gosnell stated a monitor can be purchased, as well as a new laptop computer.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. Nancy Springer stated the recent Town activities have turned out very nice.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 8:01p.m.
