

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
November 16, 2020**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Henry, Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, Superintendent White, Vicki Prettyman, Jean Holloway, and resident Nancy Springer. Commissioner Bradley was absent.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the 2nd meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5 which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated the bids for the sidewalk project were opened on November 12<sup>th</sup>. Two bids were received. Tommy Willing submitted a bid of \$44000.00 and Larry Goslee submitted a bid of \$28200.00. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to accept the lowest bid of \$28200.00 by Larry Goslee, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

The Commissioners reviewed the draft Letter of Credit from the Farmers Bank of Willards for the Pecan Corner project. Commissioner Schneider made a motion to accept the Letter of Credit, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell stated he, Commissioner Bennett, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Superintendent White, and Jason Loar from DBF had a conference call with the Secretary of MDE to discuss the ongoing issues at the Sewer Plant and emergency funding to help pay for repairing the plant. MDE stated they will review the request and follow up with any assistance they can offer.

President Gosnell stated the deadline to file for Commissioner had passed. There were two filings, Phillip D. Gosnell and George E Henry. The election will be held December 5<sup>th</sup> at 2pm at the Town Hall.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell introduced Vicki Prettyman and Jean Holloway from SERCAP. They discussed possible funding opportunities for sewer plant repairs and I & I repair.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. President Gosnell stated he and Chris went to pick up the County bucket truck to put up the Christmas lights but the bucket was not working. Superintendent White stated Wicomico County Parks and Recreation has one we can borrow. He also stated he would contact someone about putting up the flags purchased by the Historical Commission. He also stated the Town should consider replacing the Christmas lantern decorations.

Commissioner Bennet stated the Town Christmas tree lighting will be December 6<sup>th</sup> at 6pm. Masks and social distancing will be required.

Superintendent White stated the Fire Department will be driving Santa around in a fire truck.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. There were none.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 8:26p.m.
