

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
November 18, 2019**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Henry, Schneider, Bennett, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, and Secretary Adkins. Also present were Jean Cordrey and Nancy Springer. Commissioner Bradley was absent.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 4th regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Clerk/Treasurer Schneider conducted the second reading of the Critical Area Ordinance #51 Amended. President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. There were none. President Gosnell asked for Public comments. There were none. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to adopt Critical Area Ordinance #51 Amended, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell stated the dump truck has been listed on Craigslist but has not received any offers. He also stated he would like to sell the old generator from the water plant. The Commissioners agreed for Superintendent White to determine the asking price.

President Gosnell stated the Town has not been informed if we will be awarded the grant to purchase the old school. DHCD has stated they hope to make the announcements before Thanksgiving.

NEW BUSINESS:

President Gosnell stated the next ESAM meeting will be held January 21st.

President Gosnell stated the Holiday Decorating Contest judging will be held December 18th at 7pm.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Bennett stated the Town Tree Lighting will be held December 1st with refreshments to follow at the Asbury Fellowship Hall. Commissioner Schneider stated Santa's Workshop will be November 24th at the Legion from 2-4pm.

Superintendent White sent a note to say he spoke to The Matyiko's to see if they were interested in the out buildings at 502 Nanticoke Street. He also stated all of the portable toilets have been taken up at Cherry Beach. Commissioner Schneider stated he will discuss the matter at the next Parks and Recreation meeting.

President Gosnell asked for public comments. Jean Cordrey asked if DNR could provide a portable toilet since they maintain the boat ramp. Commissioner Schneider stated he would ask at the meeting.

Commissioner Henry made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:45pm.
