

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
November 20, 2017**

Commissioner Bennett called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Schneider, Henry, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, and Secretary Adkins. President Gosnell and Commissioners Bradley were absent.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 6th regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Settlement on the land for the solar project has been completed and the project construction is underway and is progressing as planned.

The Circuit Rider will start on November 27th although which town he will start in has not been determined.

The Sustainable Growth Committee will meet December 6th at 7pm.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Town Christmas lights are up and will be lit starting on Friday November 24th.

Commissioner Bennett asked for public comment. There was none.

Commissioner Bennett asked for Commissioners comments.

Commissioner Schneider stated that the Wicomico County Recreation and Parks has offered to donate some baseball bats to the Town to help replace the ones stolen in the concession stand break-in.

Commissioner Schneider read the names of appointees for the 2018 Parks and Recreation Commission. To represent Asbury Church: Ralph Cordrey and Diana Briggs, and to represent the American Legion: Scott McMahon. Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the appointees to the Parks and Recreation Commission, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor so carried.

Commissioner Schneider stated the Parks and Recreation had elected their officers for 2018.

- President: Scott McMahon
- Vice President: Mark Carroll
- Secretary: Pam Eskridge
- Treasurer: Dot Dickerson

Commissioner Henry made a motion to approve the Parks and Recreation Officers for 2018, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett stated the Historical Commission held their bake sale on November 18th and brought in \$180. The annual Tree Lighting will be Sunday December 3rd at 7pm. Pastor David Bennett will be the honored guest to “flip the switch”.

Commissioner Henry stated Planning and Zoning will meet next week and are still working on regulations for keeping chickens, as well as ducks and geese.

Commissioner Schneider asked if the Commission would consider giving the Town employees off half a day on the day before Thanksgiving. Commissioner Henry made a motion to grant the employees half a day off on the day before Thanksgiving, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

There were no other comments. Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett adjourned the meeting at 7:39pm.
