

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
December 17, 2018**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:31p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Schneider, Henry, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, and residents Bob Schneider, Gayle Schneider, Danica Schneider, Alice Schneider, Sandra Henry, and Dawn Bennett. Commissioner Bradley was absent.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 3rd regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4&5, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The Commissioners held a work session on December 12th to discuss the options for acquiring the property at 502 Nanticoke Street and to discuss options for employee retirement plans. Commissioner Schneider made a motion to allow Clerk/Treasurer Schneider to begin the process to purchase the property by tax certificate, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell reminded that the annual holiday decorating contest judging will be held Wednesday December 19<sup>th</sup>. Commissioner Schneider will assist.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Clerk/Treasurer Schneider swore in re-elected Commissioners Bennett and Schneider.

President Gosnell asked for nominations for President of the Commissioners. Commissioner Schneider nominated President Gosnell to serve as President again, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell asked for nominations for Chairman of the Commissioners. Commissioner Schneider nominated Commissioner Bennett to serve as Chairman again, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell stated the Town attorney needs to be appointed. Commissioner Henry made a motion for Paul Wilbur to remain the Town's attorney, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

The Commissioners discussed serving as liaison to the Commissions. Commissioner Schneider will remain liaison to Parks and Recreation, Commissioner Bennett will remain liaison to the Historical Commission, and Commissioner Henry will remain liaison to the Planning and Zoning Commission.

President Gosnell stated the Clerk/Treasurer needs to be appointed. Commissioner Henry made a motion for Clerk/Treasurer Schneider to continue serving, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. Commissioner Schneider abstained from voting. All were in favor and chair voted aye, so carried.

President Gosnell stated Mike Thompson has finished his term on the Planning and Zoning Commission and would like to step down. He stated resident Cody Bristow has agreed to serve. Commissioner Henry made a motion to approve the appointment of Cody Bristow to the Planning and Zoning Commission, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell stated the next LESMA meeting will be January 17<sup>th</sup> in Salisbury. Please RSVP to Secretary Adkins.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. There were none.

President Gosnell asked for public comments. There were none.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:44pm.
