

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
January 2, 2018**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, Schneider, Henry and Secretary Adkins. Circuit Rider Joe Mangini was also in attendance.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 18<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.
