

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
December 19, 2016**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, and Secretary Adkins.
