

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
December 21, 2020**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bradley, Henry, and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, and residents Sandra Henry and Nancy Springer. Commissioner Bennett was absent.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 7<sup>th</sup> meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Henry made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5 which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated the sidewalk replacement on Church Street is completed as is the repair projects on Main and State Streets. Clerk/Treasurer Schneider asked for permission to pay the second bill when it arrives. Commissioner Schneider made a motion to pay the bill for the sidewalk repairs when it is received, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell stated he met with Danny Bebee about annexing a lot on Corporation Road into town to discuss the process. Mr. Bebee has submitted his request for annexation and a meeting with Planning and Zoning will be scheduled for their review and recommendations.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Clerk/Treasurer Schneider swore in the elected Commissioners, Phillip Gosnell and George Henry.

President Gosnell asked for nominations for Commission President. Commissioner Schneider nominated Phillip Gosnell, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell asked for nominations for Chairperson. Commissioners Bradley nominated Jerry Bennett, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell appointed Judy Schneider to continue serving as Clerk/Treasurer. Commissioner Bradley made a motion to approve the appointment of Judy Schneider to continue serving as Clerk/Treasurer, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, and Chair voted aye, so carried. Commissioner Schneider abstained from voting.

President Gosnell appointed Paul Wilbur to continuing serving as the Town Attorney. Commissioner Bradley made a motion to approve the appointment of Paul Wilbur as the Town Attorney, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

The Commissioners discussed the Town Hall hours for Christmas Eve. Commissioner Schneider made a motion for the Town Hall to be closed on Christmas Eve, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. There were none.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. There were none.

Commissioner Henry made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:43p.m.
