

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
December 2, 2019**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:31p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Henry, Schneider, Bennett, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Superintendent White, Attorney Roscoe Leslie, and Secretary Adkins. Nancy Springer was also present. Commissioner Bradley was absent.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 18<sup>th</sup> Public Hearing, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 18<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated the Town was awarded a \$50,000 grant to purchase the old school building.

The Commissioners read an update from Circuit Rider Joe Mangini. Also he has scheduled a meeting for December 19<sup>th</sup> with SERCAP to discuss grant opportunities.

President Gosnell stated the port-a-potties at Cherry Beach are provided by a grant for 8 months out of the year. Commissioner Schneider stated he will contact Parks and Recreation about getting one for the remainder of the year.

Superintendent White updated the Commissioners on how the Sewer plant is operating. He stated they have worked on the Town Christmas lights and they all should be working. He also stated Expert House Movers/Matyiko did take one of the out buildings from the 502 Nanticoke Street property.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell dispersed the Commissioners checks for the year.

President Gosnell stated the employee Christmas luncheon would be held December 18<sup>th</sup>.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Henry asked if reflectors could be put on the fire hydrant near Dollar General for better visibility. Superintendent White stated he would look into that.

Commissioner Schneider stated the 2020 officers for Parks and Recreation will be President Mark Carroll, Vice President Scott McMahan, Secretary Pam Eskridge, and Treasurer Dot Dickerson.

Commissioner Bennett reported on the Christmas tree lighting.

Attorney Leslie stated he has accepted a new job effective January 1<sup>st</sup>. He expressed his appreciation for working with the Town over the years.

President Gosnell asked for public comments. Nancy Springer stated Santa's Workshop was a very nice event.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:56pm.
