

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
February 16, 2021**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Henry, and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, and several residents. Commissioner Bradley was absent.

NEW BUSINESS:

Gardner Signs has agreed to replace one of the banners, which tore. The Historical Commission will be having some fundraising raffles. Larry Goslee has laid cement for the memorial pavers at the park.

Commissioner Schneider stated Parks and Recreation has a meeting scheduled for that week.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. There were none.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.
