

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
March 1, 2021**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, Henry, and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, Superintendent White, Joe Mangini, Attorney Mike Mathers, and Nancy Springer.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 15th meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Henry made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5 which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated he, Circuit Rider Joe Mangini, and Bhaskar from DNR met with the property owner to discuss the plans for the repairs to the bulkhead. All parties were agreeable with the proposed plans.

Circuit Rider Joe Mangini stated he has submitted the final reports for the 502 Nanticoke Street grant and the Old School grant.

President Gosnell stated an online post was made about allowing people to remove the trees around the Old School building. The Commissioners and Attorney Mathers discussed allowing people to remove the trees and it was decided it would be too much of a liability to allow it. Secretary Adkins will remove the post from the internet.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Clerk/Treasurer Schneider introduced and read aloud, the Bebee Properties LLC Annexation Resolution 2021-04-05A and Resolution 2021-04-05B. The resolutions and annexation plan are available to be viewed at the Town Hall. The public hearing for the Annexation will be held Monday April 5<sup>th</sup> at 7pm.

President Gosnell stated the new sidewalk on Church Street has cracked. It appears a large vehicle drove over it. He has spoked to Larry Goslee about getting an estimate to fix it.

President Gosnell stated he will be meeting with Danny Sparrow from Wicomico County Roads Division to discuss putting slurry on Church Street.

President Gosnell stated he received a request from the “That Kitchen” food truck to set up at Cherry Beach. The Commissioners agreed that would be fine.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Schneider stated the Parks and Recreation will sponsor a Catfish Tournament on March 20<sup>th</sup>.

Superintendent White and the Commissioners discussed Municipal Infractions. The courts are several months behind in cases. Superintendent White stated the flows at the sewer plant are still very high from all of the rain so it is not possible to begin the repair project yet. He also stated the solar panels are being worked on.

Superintendent White and the Commissioners discussed some areas on State Street that need repairs or repaving.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. Nancy Springer stated the churches are reopened for in person services and longtime resident Charles “Lefty” Wright had passed away.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 8:06p.m.
