

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
April 16, 2018**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, Schneider, Henry, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, and Secretary Adkins. Residents Jean Cordrey, Sandy Rose and Sheriff's Deputy John Alessandrini were also present.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 2nd regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

President Gosnell stated we are waiting for Delmarva Power's Green Power Division to approve the transfer to the new service at the water plant for the solar project.

President Gosnell stated construction is continuing on the Dollar General. The water line is in and the sewer line will be installed soon.

The Commissioners reviewed an email update from Circuit Rider Joe Mangini. Commissioner Bennett stated several people met at the historical commission building to assess if the building is able to be repaired.

President Gosnell stated he spoke with Lee Outten and they have not begun to apply slurry to the roads in Wicomico County, and he will let us know a few days in advance before they come to Sharptown.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Commissioners reviewed a request letter from the Historical Commission. The first request was to accept the resignation of Bonnie Abner from the Historical Commission. Commission Schneider made a motion to accept the resignation, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried. The second request was to approve the membership renewals of Alfred Bailey, Tom Bennett, Edna Silvia, Dixie Eddy, Linda Murphy, Audrey English, and Doug McGee. Commissioner Henry made a motion to approve the renewals, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell stated the MERC barge will be returning the week of April 23rd.

The June LESMA meeting will be held in Sharptown on June 21st at the American Legion. Jerry Fletcher will be catering and the guest speaker will be Mike Pennington from the Tri-County Council.

Sherriff Deputy John Alessandrini reviewed police report stats with the Commissioners.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Bennett stated the Historical Commission hosted their speaker, Terry Crannell, and it was very informative. The Commissioners discussed the charging of church parsonages for their water use and agreed to discuss further while working on the next budget.

President Gosnell asked for public comments. There were none

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 8:07pm.
