

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
April 3, 2017**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:31p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, Henry, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, Superintendent White and Attorney Roscoe Leslie. Commissioner Schneider was absent. Also present was resident Jean Cordrey.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 20th regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The town wide clean up day will be held April 29<sup>th</sup> from 8am to 4pm.

The RSVP for the Spring ESAM meeting is due April 7<sup>th</sup>.

The Commissioners reviewed an email from Aaron Goller with updates on the projects in process:

- Dollar General: comments on the plan and plat will be sent by next week.
- Solar Project: advertising for bids will be sent out April 12<sup>th</sup>
- I&I Project: USDA has approved applications. The project is competing for funding with other projects (3 projects, only funding 2). There may be more funding available April 28<sup>th</sup> if not funded prior to then.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

The building used for the historical museum is loaned to the Town and is in need of repair. The Historical Commission has requested that the Commissioners send a letter to the owner asking if he would consider donating the property to the Town. If the Town owns the property, then it would be eligible for grants to restore the property. Commissioner Bradley made a motion to send the owner a letter asking to donate the building to the town, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

The Planning and Zoning Commission met on March 27<sup>th</sup> to review the plans for the Dollar General, discuss the re-zoning and re-subdivision, and to discuss changes and updates to the Zoning ordinance. They will be meeting again on April 25<sup>th</sup>.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Bennett stated the Historical Commission would be having a bake sale April 15<sup>th</sup>.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. Resident Jean Cordrey stated it would have been great if the bypass could be widened while they are paving it to accommodate the tractor trailers that will be coming to the Dollar General.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:46 p.m.
