

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
May 17, 2021**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, Henry, and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, and Nancy Springer.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5 which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated there is a virtual meeting with MDE on May 25<sup>th</sup> at the DBF offices to discuss the Sewer Plant issues.

President Gosnell stated the water tower painting is completed and looks good.

President Gosnell stated the paving projects around Town are done. He spoke to the contractor who will do the slurry on Church Street and he states we are on their schedule.

President Gosnell stated he contacted the County about the street sweeper coming to Town, but at this time they do not have the manpower to do it. If/when they are able to do it, they will contact us.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated the next ESAM meeting will be held on June 28<sup>th</sup> in Ocean City, RSVP by June 18<sup>th</sup>.

Clerk/Treasurer Schneider introduced and read Circuit Rider Application Resolution 2021-05-17. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pass Resolution 2021-05-17, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

The Commissioners scheduled a Work Session for May 24<sup>th</sup> at 7pm to discuss the 2021/2022 FY Budget.

Superintendent White submitted a written report that during flow testing on the Town fire hydrants, they found a significant drop in pressure on Joe Morgan Road. He believes a valve has closed, causing the issue. He recommends the valve be replaced as soon as possible. The Commissioners reviewed a quote from TK Construction in the amount of \$6971.00 to replace the water valve on Joe Morgan Road. After discussion, Commissioner Bradley made a motion to approve the valve replacement by TK Construction for the quoted amount of \$6971.00, and to use money from the Rainy Day fund to pay for it, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. Also, the Town employees will remove and repair any damage it causes to the road.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Parks and Recreation- Commissioner Schneider stated that Softball has started. There are plans in progress to have fireworks on Heritage Day. Asbury UMC submitted the names of David Bennett and Ralph Cordrey to serve on Parks and Recreation. Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the appointment of David Bennett and Ralph Cordrey, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

Historical Commission- Commissioner Bennett and Nancy Springer reported there was no update on the banners. They are looking into being able to accept online donations, and the plans for Heritage Day are ongoing.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. Nancy Springer stated she is hearing many people complaining about cars speeding and driving unsafely around Town. President Gosnell stated he would request a Sherriff's deputy attend the next meeting to hear complaints.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:59p.m.
