

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
July 15, 2019**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, Schneider, and Henry, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, and Secretary Adkins. Residents Jean Cordrey, Nancy Springer, and Lt. Tim Robinson were also present.

Commissioner Schneider a motion to approve the minutes from the July 1<sup>st</sup> regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated County Executive Bob Culver would be holding a town hall meeting in Sharptown at the Memorial Building on September 12<sup>th</sup>.

President Gosnell stated he met with Kirk Kinnamon and reviewed the plans the sidewalks and curb/guttering on State Street. Aaron Goller approved the plans, so President Gosnell signed off on them.

President Gosnell stated DCHD will do a site visit at the old elementary school on July 31<sup>st</sup> at 3pm.

Commissioner Bradley asked if there is any updates on driving golf carts in town, President Gosnell stated he has not received one. Lt. Robinson stated he believes if the golf cart is slow moving, battery powered, and has an orange triangle warning sign on it, it should be okay to drive in town.

Commissioner Bennett asked if there any updated on sidewalk grants. President Gosnell stated no but he plans to meet with Tracey Gordy in September to discuss and prioritize applying for grants.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated ESAM is having a social event at the Shorebirds stadium on August 8<sup>th</sup>. Please RSVP by August 1<sup>st</sup>.

President Gosnell stated the town fire hydrants will be flushed on July 17<sup>th</sup>.

President Gosnell stated there was an issue with the pumps at the sewer plant. The alarm went off for high levels but there was no overflow. At this time it is unclear what the problem was but they are working properly now.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Schneider stated that 75 kids have signed up for soccer this year.

Commissioner Bennett stated the Historical Commission is planning Heritage Day. They are selling chances for this year's raffle at Wrights Market's Watermelon Festival.

President Gosnell asked for public comments. Lt. Tim Robinson stated the Town had not had many calls in the previous quarter. Resident Jean Cordrey suggested the Parks and Recreation take a photo before and after the Pavilion is used to show if they are cleaning up after themselves or not.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:51pm.
