

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
July 18, 2022**

Commissioner Bennett called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Henry, Bradley, and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, and members of the public. President Gosnell was absent.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 5th regular meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5 which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Bennett stated one bid/proposal was received for the structural engineering study at the Old School building. Davis Bowen & Friedel submitted a proposal of \$8,850.00 for the Structural Feasibility Study. Commissioner Schneider made a motion to accept the proposal of \$8,850.00 from Davis Bowen & Friedel for the Old School Engineering Study, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett stated the repairs are complete at the sewer plant and they expecting to begin refilling plant 2 tomorrow.

Commissioner Bennett stated the sidewalk project is ongoing. Larry Goslee is working in sections as his schedule allows and the availability of concrete. The Commissioners discussed other streets that also need their sidewalks replaced.

NEW BUSINESS:

There was no new business to discuss.

Commissioner Bennett asked for Commissioner comments. Commissioner Schneider and Mark Carroll stated Parks and Recreation soccer sign-ups are ongoing.

Commissioner Bennett and Nancy Springer stated the Historical Commission is almost completely moved out of the museum building. Arrangements are being made to move the larger items this week. They are expecting to be out completely by the end of July.

Wicomico County Sherriff Department Lt. John Alessandrini reviewed calls for service from the last quarter.

Commissioner Bennett asked for public comment, there was none.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett adjourned the meeting at 7:40p.m.
