

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
July 5, 2022**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Henry, and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, Joe Mangini, Erica Witz, and members of the public. Commissioner Bradley was absent.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the public hearing held on June 21st, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Henry made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 21st regular meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5 which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no update on the sewer project.

President Gosnell stated the sidewalk project is ongoing and there are supply issues with getting concrete.

Circuit Rider Joe Mangini stated the pre-bid meeting for the engineering grant was held June 30th. The bids are due by July 15th. The Towns “sustainable community” will need to be renewed in 2023, and Mr. Mangini will begin working on that in September.

NEW BUSINESS:

The next LESMA meeting will be held July 21st in Berlin.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioner comments. Commissioner Bennett discussed the Historical Commission moving out of the museum building.

Attorney Erica Witz discussed the County doing the Towns plumbing inspections.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. There were none.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:48p.m.
