

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
July 6, 2020**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Henry, Schneider, Bennett, Bradley, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, Attorney Mike Mathers, Joe Mangini, Jeff Merritt, and resident Nancy Springer.

Commissioner Henry made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 15th meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5 which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Circuit Rider Joe Mangini gave an update on projects being worked on. The 502 Nanticoke Street property needs to be cleaned up and then can be conveyed to Operation We Care. He will look into getting estimates for clean-up.

The grant for the Old School was discussed. We received the grant for \$50000.00 and the seller is asking \$59000.00. Mr. Mangini will discuss options with the State on how to make up the difference.

Mr. Mangini stated the next step in the Shoreline Restoration project is for DNR to complete the project design.

Mr. Mangini stated the grant for his position was approved for 1 year and will be funded through November 2021.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Commissioners discussed the maintenance contract for the water tower. President Gosnell stated he met with Southern Corrosion and they will be submitting a proposal.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Bennett stated there was an old tree stump on the Verizon property that has become a nesting site for snakes and he has received complaints. He requested a letter be sent asking Verizon to remove the stump.

Commissioner Schneider stated Parks and Recreation has opened registrations for the soccer league.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. There were none.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 8:12p.m.
