

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES**

August 1, 2022

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, Erica Witz, Joe Mangini, and members of the public. Commissioner Henry was absent.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 18th regular meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5 which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

President Gosnell stated that Sewer Plant #2 had a leak in it that was found when they were refilling it. It is being emptied so the repairs can be made.

President Gosnell stated the sidewalk project is ongoing.

Circuit Rider Joe Mangini stated Davis Bowen & Friedel would begin the structural engineering study of the old school on August 2nd.

NEW BUSINESS:

President Gosnell read a donation request from the Parks and Recreation to help pay for fireworks on Heritage Day. Clerk/Treasurer Schneider stated last year the Commissioners donated \$1,000.00. Commissioner Schneider made a motion to donate \$1,000.00 to the Parks and Recreation for fireworks, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

Clerk/Treasurer Schneider read a draft Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Wicomico County and the Town which allows the County to perform Plumbing Inspections on behalf of the Town. The Commissioners asked Attorney Erica Witz to make a change to number 3 on the agreement, to state that the inspection fees will be paid directly to the County. Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adopt the MOU with Wicomico County, with the requested change to number 3, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioner comments. Commissioner Schneider and Mark Carroll stated the soccer season has started. The next Parks and Recreation meeting will be held on Saturday August 20th due to members working at the carnival.

Commissioner Bennett stated the Historical Commission expressed their thanks to the volunteers who helped move the large items out of the museum building.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. James Winn, candidate for Wicomico County Council At-Large thanked the residents of Sharptown for their support in the Primary Election.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:45p.m.
