

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
August 20, 2018**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bradley, Bennett, and Henry, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, and resident Jean Cordrey. Commissioner Schneider was absent.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to approve the minutes from the August 6th regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

President Gosnell stated he will meet with Aaron Goller from DBF on Wednesday to go over the items needed to be completed at Pecan Corner.

President Gosnell stated he, along with Circuit Rider Joe Mangini and Historical Commission Chairperson Teresa Herring, met with Mr. Disharoon to discuss the museum. Mr. Disharoon will accept \$20,000.00 as payment for the building. Mr. Mangini is working to get a grant to pay for acquiring the building and repairs needed.

President Gosnell stated he spoke with SHA District Engineer Jay Meredith about the safety concerns concerning the ditches around the bypass, and he agreed to get them cut for us.

NEW BUSINESS:

President Gosnell stated the Town has officially been designated as a “Sustainable Community”, which will open up the town to more grant opportunities.

The town hall will be closed Monday September 3rd; the next meeting will be Tuesday September 4th.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. There were none.

President Gosnell asked for public comments. There were none.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.
