

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
August 2, 2021**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, Henry, and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, Attorney Erica Witz, Joe Mangini, and several residents.

President Gosnell stated he spoke with Attorney Mathers for guidance concerning the profane political sign.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Bennett suggested listing what the difference tones on the fire siren mean in the next newsletter.

Commissioner Schneider and Parks and Recreation President Mark Carroll discussed the soccer program.

Commissioner Bennett and Nancy Springer discussed ongoing plans for Heritage Day.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. There were none.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.
