

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
September 16, 2019**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Schneider, Henry, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider and Secretary Adkins. Also in attendance were residents Jean Cordrey and Nancy Springer. Commissioner Bradley was absent.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 3rd regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

President Gosnell stated the sewer sampling at manholes around town has been completed and we are waiting to receive the results.

President Gosnell stated the mixer has been repaired in the PAX System at the water plant.

President Gosnell stated he, Superintendant White, and Mr. Mangini met with the Department of Natural Resources to discuss funding options/grants for repairs to the bulk head. Their suggestion is to apply for a MEMA Pre-Disaster Mitigation grant due to the fact the sewer plant is so close to the river.

President Gosnell stated the County Executive's town hall meeting went well and many issues were discussed.

President Gosnell asked Clerk/Treasurer Schneider to report on 502 Nanticoke Street. She stated the attorney stated the court needs to sign off on the foreclosure and then the deed can be written up.

The Commissioners reviewed a quote for \$580.00 from DC Wildlife Control to seal off the exterior of the Town Hall from bats getting in. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the quote from DC Wildlife Control in the amount of \$580.00, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

There was no new business to be discussed.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Schneider stated the Parks and Recreation movie night and soap box derby both went well.

Commissioner Bennett stated the painting on the poles on Main Street has been cleaned off. He also stated the Historical Commission is looking for vendors for Heritage Day on October 19th.

President Gosnell asked for public comments. Nancy Springer stated Mount Vernon Church will be having a BBQ chicken fundraiser at the Hardware Store on September 28th.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:54pm.
