

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
September 17, 2018**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Henry, and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, Superintendent White, Aaron Goller from Davis, Bowen, and Friedel, Teresa Herring, County Executive Bob Culver, Clerk of Court Candidate Chris Welch, as well as several residents. Commissioner Bradley was absent.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 4<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4&5, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated before the meeting, he, Superintendent White, and Aaron Goller met on scene at Pecan Corner to review the plans submitted for sidewalks and discuss what needs to be done there to satisfy the Public Works Agreement. Mr. Goller recommended requiring curbing and sidewalks down State Street to the Dollar General. The Commissioners agreed with this recommendation. Mr. Goller stated he will draft a letter to the developer stating the Town's requirements. Superintendent White stated widening State Street has been discussed in the past and suggested widening the road now to prevent tearing up the sidewalks in the future. The Commissioners also discussed street lights for State Street. Three new construction building permits have been received but will not be issued until an approved set of plans is received.

The Commissioners reviewed the Circuit Rider Update. Mr. Mangini is working to find an appraiser who may be willing to work with the town on the cost of a second appraisal on the Historical Museum building. Chairperson Herring stated she would ask Mr. Mangini to contact Mr. Disharoon about a termite inspection.

Superintendent White stated he is working to get prices to repair the affluent line.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated the next town election will be held on December 1<sup>st</sup>. Janet Fox and Nancy Springer have agreed to continue as election judges but a third judge will need to be appointed. President Gosnell asked the Commissioners to submit any names they may have for the position.

Heritage Day was cancelled due to an impending hurricane. The Historical Commission has requested to hold an open house at the Town Hall on November 4<sup>th</sup> from 2pm to 4pm to dedicate the shad barge and to view other items on display. Commissioner Schneider made a motion to allow the Historical Commission to hold an open house on November 4<sup>th</sup>, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

Chairperson Herring stated the Historical Commission has received a request to join from Brenda Lankford Childs. Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the appointment of Brenda Lankford Childs to the Historical Commission, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. There were none.

President Gosnell asked for public comments. There were none.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 8:14pm.
