

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
September 21, 2020**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bradley, Schneider, Henry, Bennett, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, and Nancy Springer.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 8<sup>th</sup> meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5 which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The Commissioners discussed Halloween and trick or treating. Parks and Recreation has decided to cancel the Halloween Party and Hayrides. Instead they discussed having a virtual costume contest. Parks and Recreation suggested closing off some streets to allow for more room to socially distance during trick or treating. The Commissioners agreed to allow trick or treating from 5pm to 8pm. The Parks and Recreation will submit suggested streets to be closed by the next meeting.

President Gosnell reminded the Commissioners of the work session scheduled for Wednesday September 30<sup>th</sup> at 7pm.

President Gosnell stated bid requests were sent out to clean up 502 Nanticoke Street. Bids/Estimates are due by the next meeting night, October 5<sup>th</sup>.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

The Commissioners reviewed a request from the Farmers Bank of Willards to use a letter guaranteeing warranty for the Pecan Corner project instead of issuing a bond. The bank is also the developer and cannot issue a bond to itself. President Gosnell will send the request to the Town Attorney for his opinion. The topic will be discussed at the work session.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Bennett asked about replacing sidewalks. President Gosnell stated he will contact Wicomico County to discuss if sidewalks and street paving need to be done at the same time.

Commissioner Bennett and Nancy Springer stated a Historical Commission member, Fran Todd, wishes to remove herself from the Commission. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to remove Fran Todd from the Historical Commission, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried. Commissioner Bennett stated the Historical Commission has ordered red, white, and blue flags for the poles, and residents can pay for memorial flags for Veterans.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. There were none.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:51p.m.
