

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
January 16, 2024**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:31p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Henry and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, and Secretary Manes

The Pledge of Allegiance was performed.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry, Chair voted, "Aye" so carried.

Commissioner Henry made a motion to pay the bills as stated on page 4, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. Chair voted, "Aye" so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

President Gosnell asked for the Commissioners to look over the draft of the cannabis resolution. It was agreed that on page three (3), number four (4) be changed to say, "The Town shall have and reserve the right to renew, extend, or modify this moratorium for such additional period or periods by making a motion".

Superintendent White left an update with President Gosnell. He stated that Well #6 was re-tested for bacteria and the results came back negative.

He stated that he also received quotes from The Tree Guy and M&B to cut trees at Town Hall, Fourth Street, State Street, and Corporation Road. The Tree Guy has quoted the best price at \$3050.00. Commissioner Schneider made a motion to hire The Tree Guy, with a second from Commissioner Henry. Chair voted, "Aye" so carried.

Over the weekend, the sewer on Taylor Street had to be pumped out twice, Chesapeake Environmental Services (CES) had to come out and they got it cleared.

NEW BUSINESS:

Sharptown Parks and Recreation has submitted the names of the newly elected officers for 2024. Chairman Mark Carroll, Vice Chairman JR Adkins, Treasurer Pam Eskridge, and Secretary Katie Manes. Commissioner Schneider moved that we approve the 2024 officers with a second from Commissioner Henry. Chair voted, "Aye" so carried.

President Gosnell presented the name of a new Planning & Zoning member, Kevin Kress. Rick Nagler has stepped down. Commissioner Schneider moved that we approve Kevin Kress to the Planning and Zoning Committee with a second from Commissioner Henry. Chair voted, "Aye" so carried.

There were no Commissioner comments.

Commissioner Henry made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. Chair voted, “Aye” so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:45 p.m.
