

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
July 15, 2024**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Henry, Schneider, and Bradley, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Manes, and Mark Carroll.

The Pledge of Allegiance was performed.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All agreed, so carried.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All agreed, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

President Gosnell reported that himself and Circuit Rider Mangini met with DNR on July 9. DNR proposed that the living shoreline/bulkhead project also include parts extending to the ballfield. On July 30th, President Gosnell will meet with Chuck Poole and Chuck Rousseau from the County to discuss the possibility.

President Gosnell stated that he spoke with Mike Houck in regards to the road striping on Main Street. Mr. Houck agreed to paint black over it if we so choose, or if we choose to keep the lines as is then we will only be charged the cost of the paint, which is \$650.00. Commissioner Bradley made a motion to leave the yellow striping as is and pay for just the cost of the paint, with a second from Commissioner Schneider.

The Commissioners agreed that the jump in price of the MML dues is too great. Commissioner Henry made a motion to drop our MML membership, with a second from Commissioner Schneider. All agreed, so carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

The LESMA dinner for July will be the last one under President Earl Murphy.

There is a request for a new at-large member to join Sharptown Recreation and Parks. Denise Carroll was accepted with a motion from Commissioner Schneider and a second from Commissioner Bradley. All agreed, so carried.

The Town had its annual Bike Parade on July 14th, and it was very well attended. Everyone was pleased that the tradition has continued.

Mark Carroll reported that regular registration for soccer runs until August 1, 2024. Currently, there are one hundred fifty-four (154) players registered.

There were no public comments.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All agreed, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:48 p.m.
