

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
August 19, 2024**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Henry, Schneider, Bennett and via Google Meets, Commissioner Bradley. Also present were Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Manes, Wicomico County Sheriff's Office Captain Rich Wiersberg and Lieutenant John Alessandrini, Nancy Springer, and Mark Carroll.

The Pledge of Allegiance was performed.

Commissioner Henry made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All agreed, so carried.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All agreed, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Circuit Rider Mangini reported that Unity Landscaping sent over a comprehensive proposal to be signed in order to keep the work for the living shoreline moving forward. The Commissioners agreed to table the proposal pending further clarification regarding the fees listed.

President Gosnell stated that Resolution #2024-02-05 regarding the cannabis moratorium needed to be extended. A motion was made by Commissioner Bennett to extend the resolution for another six (6) months with a second from Commissioner Henry. All agreed, so carried.

President Gosnell reported that he received a quote from Houck Construction to apply four (4) 25MPH decals on the road. Materials and installation would be \$2350.00. The Commissioners agreed to look into additional options including having the Town do it and pricing out other companies.

He also reported that the County Council has their regularly scheduled meeting tomorrow morning, August 20th at 10:00 a.m. where the MOU for the Town parks will be voted on.

NEW BUSINESS:

There was no new business.

President Gosnell asked for public comments.

Ms. Nancy said that the plans for Heritage Day are coming along

Mark reported that a group of Sharptown kids contacted a Salisbury skate shop owner and had him come out to Sharptown to get his opinion and information on a potential skate park. Mark stated that there is a grant that would cover the costs, but it would have to be backed by the

Town. He thinks that permanent restroom facilities could potentially be part of this grant as well. The Commissioners agreed that a plan should be submitted to them by the interested parties. Commissioner Bennett agreed to oversee the project.

Mark reported the Sharptown Recreation and Parks meeting this month will be on August 27th, after the carnival has ended.

Captain Wiersberg and Lieutenant Alessandrini from the Wicomico County Sheriff's Office reported on the shooting that took place at Cherry Beach on August 11th. There was a large group of people who all decided to meet up there to party. Words were exchanged and shots were fired by multiple people, but no one was hit. Four (4) cars have been seized in relation to this incident.

Lieutenant Alessandrini announced that he is retiring at the end of August after twenty (20) years of service.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioner comments. Commissioner Bennett stated that the area around the Cope Bennett sign needs attention. President Gosnell said that he would contact Chuck Poole from the County regarding it.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All agreed, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 8:15 p.m.
