

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
September 16, 2024**

It is very long and detailed and will be tabled until the Commissioners can read through it thoroughly. Mark Carroll asked the Commission if he could have permission to move forward with grant paperwork to see if it even gets approved. A motion was made by Commissioner Bennett with a second from Commissioner Henry. All agreed, so carried.

President Gosnell announced that after twenty-eight (28) years of service that he will not be running again in the upcoming election for Commission President.
