

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
November 18, 2024**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Henry, Schneider, Bennett, and Bradley. Also present were, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Manes, and Mark Carroll.

Jerry stated that the Tree Lighting and Santa's Workshop will be on November 30<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the church.

Mark Carroll stated that the Sharptown adult soccer team played the Wor-Wic soccer team a second time and Sharptown won against them again.
