

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
February 17, 2026**

Superintendent White reported that the flow meter for the waste water plant shipped today. He also said that violation letters were sent out regarding unlicensed/untagged vehicles and all have complied. There was a letter sent regarding the junk/debris on the vacant property of 404 Taylor Street. A resident on Main Street sent a complaint via email regarding a mattress on a porch on an adjacent property. A letter has already been sent to the property owner, as it violates Ordinance 29 - Junk/Debris

President Schneider closed the meeting to enter into a closed session to discuss the shoreline at 7:39 p.m.

President Schneider reopened the meeting at 7:47 p.m.

The Commissioner have decided to make Saturday, April 18, 2026 the Town-Wide Clean Up Day. A motion was made by Commissioner Bradley to get two (2) dumpsters for that day, with a second from Commissioner Bennett.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All agreed, so carried.
