

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
June 15, 2026**

It was reported that Hebron Savings Bank in Town is getting an ATM installed.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All agreed, so carried.
