

SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
July 20, 2026

President Schneider called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Henry and Carroll. Also present were, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider and Secretary Favinger

The Pledge of Allegiance was performed.

Commissioner Carroll made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. Chair votes Aye, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no Circuit Rider report.

Water Meter Project - Discussion tabled until Superintendent White can be present.

President Schneider stated that a Simple Fiber is interested in the parcel on Rt. 313 referred to as the "Halloween Hill" area.

NEW BUSINESS:

The County sent a document to us asking for preliminary input on the "LPPRP", Land Preservation, Parks & Recreation Plan. This plan is to help develop capital projects that can help bridge gaps in facility and recreational programming within the County. Currently, the items we are looking at are park cameras and upgrading the concession stand at Cherry Beach.

President Schneider reported that we have requested quotes for road paving around Town. We have only received one back so far. He will update the Commission as they come in.

Commissioner Carroll stated that the wooden section of the concession stand at Cope Bennett that has the graffiti on it will be re-painted. A mural may be painted there in the future to help deter graffiti.

Commissioner Henry reported that there is a Sharptown Planning & Zoning meeting scheduled for Tuesday, July 28, 2026 regarding the State's recent ADU requirements.

Commissioner Carroll made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. Chair votes Aye, so carried.

President Schneider adjourned the meeting at 7:39 p.m.
